Happy Tails Doggie Daycare Information and Policies

Happy Tails Doggie Daycare is to provide, a safe, fun and stimulating social environment for dogs. We require all guests to comply with the following policies to ensure the safety and health of your pet.

Age: All dogs must be at least eight weeks of age or older.

All dogs 6 months of age and older must be spayed or neutered.

Vaccinations: All dogs must have up to date vaccines according to the vaccination schedule recommended by your veterinarian. Owners must submit written proof of DHLPP and bordatella. Titers will be accepted in lieu of vaccines for dogs over 1 year of age. Rabies is required for puppies over 3 months of age.

Health: All dogs must be in good health. Owners will be asked to certify that their dog(s) are in good health and have not been ill with a communicable condition in the last 30 days. Upon admission to doggie daycare all dogs must be free from any condition that could potentially jeopardize other guests. Dogs that have been ill with a communicable condition in the last 30 days will need a veterinarian certification of health to be admitted or readmitted.

Behavior: No aggressive behavior will be permitted. Dogs must not be protective of food or toys. Owners will be asked to certify that their dogs have not harmed or shown any aggressive or threatening behavior towards any person or any other dog. Your pet will be interacting with other pets and the safety and health of all animals is our priority.

Play group activities: Our professionals at Happy Tails understand the physical, emotional and social nature of your dog. All dogs participate in play groups and activities according to their individual needs, social skills and play styles. Dogs are constantly supervised and monitored. Some dogs enjoy lots of intense activity while others prefer quieter play and extra cuddle time. Rest periods between play sessions are crucial for the health and safety of your dog. Rest periods rotated with play sessions and cuddle time will fulfill the physical, emotional and social needs of your dog and still allow for a tired and well exercised pet at the end of the day. Dogs must rest. Dogs can become overly aroused, stressed and irritable if they are forced to be in a non stop environment for a long period of time. Dogs that are overly tired and over stimulated will be more inclined to fight. Your dog's safety and well being is our priority.

- We reserve the right to act in the best interest of one dog or all dogs which may include removing a dog from group playtime activities.

4. I further understand and agree that any problems which develop with my dog will be treated as deemed best by the staff of Happy Tails at their sole discretion and that I assume full financial responsibility for any and all expenses involved.
